From Farmland to School- LACC's Humble Beginnings

One of nine college campuses of the Los Angeles Community College District, what is now Los Angeles City College was originally a farm outside of Los Angeles. When the Pacific Electric Interurban Railroad connected downtown Los Angeles and Hollywood in 1909, the area began to develop rapidly. In 1914, the Los Angeles Board of Education moved the California State Normal School, a school to train teachers, from downtown Los Angeles to Vermont Avenue in Hollywood.
