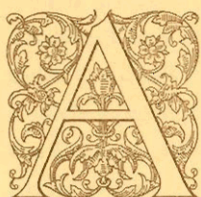


Berkeley Square

Act III

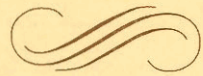
- Scene 1. Afternoon in 1784, a week later.
