3. Skills Certificate in Music Technology, Music Performance, or Music Composition
4. Transfer to a four-year school or music conservatory as a music major

## LACC Music Academy

Students accepted as Herb Alpert Scholars may qualify for the LACC Music Academy, which provides private lessons to promising music students who are planning to transfer to a four-year institution as music majors.

Students accepted into the LACC Music Academy are expected to meet the following:

1. Be a Music major at LACC for at least four semesters, enrolled in at least 12 units each semester in the following classes:

- Applied Music Laboratory: Music 180
- Applied Music Courses: Music 181, 182, 183 or 184
- Theory<sup>1</sup>: Complete Harmony Series (I, II & III) and/or Music History, Counterpoint, 20th Century Techniques, Orchestration
- Piano<sup>1</sup>: Music 311, 312, 313, 314, 341-1/2/3/4
- Current Musical Events<sup>1</sup>: Music 152 or equivalent unit in music
- Performance Ensemble appropriate to the area of emphasis: Music 531, 561, 705, 711, 725, 751, 765, 771 or 781
- General Education<sup>2</sup> other than Physical Education, Health, or ESL

2. Practice at least 5½ hours per week in the LACC Music Department practice rooms (Music 180)

3. Attend 16 half-hour (or 8 one-hour) individual lessons from a music professor each week

4. Attend a one-hour Master Class (Music 181-184) each week

5. Participate in an end of the semester jury examination including technique, musicianship, sight-reading, and memorized repertoire

6. Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.2
