

Dear Students,

With the exception of the Learning Foundations courses listed below, **all** LACC courses will meet in a remote learning (online) environment beginning March 30th. This includes our noncredit courses and our dual enrollment courses offered at local high schools and middle schools. This change is being done to minimize the potential of COVID-19 transmission and adhere to the Los Angeles Mayor's and California Governor's stay-at-home orders. Your professors have been preparing and transitioning their courses to this new online format since last Monday and many continue to do so during this week's spring break.

Some of you may have attempted to contact your instructors this week. Please be patient if they have not responded. They are working tirelessly to get their courses ready for Monday, March 30th and many of them are spending the time during spring break with their families. Rest assured they will be contacting you when the semester resumes next Monday, March 30th. If you have not done so, please log in to the student portal to ensure you can access the canvas shell for each class that you are currently enrolled in. You should be able to see the "course cards" for each of your classes on your Canvas dashboard, but you may not be able to enter the actual class until the faculty member is ready and "publishes" the course shell. They should all be open to you by Monday. At that time, if you are still unable to access, you can let the professor know the shell is not yet open.

The following courses (table 1) will **not** be meeting online or in person on March 30th. These courses are temporarily suspended until it is safe for them to be scheduled to meet back on campus. Students in the Learning Foundations courses will be contacted separately by Professor Donna Morley.
