Course Description

Pronunciation and grammar, practical vocabulary, useful phrases; basic facts on the geography, customs and culture of Korea.

Advisory

English 28 or equivalent.

Student Learning Outcomes

Compose and perform an oral skit in a group, 5-7 lines per person.

Criteria

Skit script content, grammar, and vocabulary; oral delivery pronunciation and fluency.

Rubric

Exemplary: The oral skit script is rich in cultural content and almost free of grammatical or spelling errors, and orally delivered with accurate enunciation and fluency.

Acceptable: The oral skit script has some cultural content and minor grammatical or spelling errors, and orally delivered with comprehensible enunciation and pace.

Unacceptable: The oral skit script is lacking in cultural content and contains enough grammar and spelling error to interfere with the comprehension of the sentences. The oral delivery is incomprehensible with inaccurate enunciation and pauses.
