Course Description

A review of grammar and idiomatic expression. Intensive and extensive reading and discussion of Korean tradition and contemporary culture and social issues.

Student Learning Outcomes

Write a detailed recipe and instruction for cooking a dish and make an oral presentation.

Criteria

Give directions in a complicated task using connectives and sentence endings that reflect subtle nuances in the speech. Employing complex adjectives and adverbs.

Rubric

Exemplary: The recipe and instruction is full of detailed explanation for cooking and presentation. Sophisticated and varied uses of connectives and sentence endings. Mastery of an extensive vocabulary.

Acceptable: The recipe and instruction contain adequate explanation for cooking and presentation. Correct uses of connectives and sentence endings.

Command good vocabulary.

Unacceptable: The recipe and instruction is difficult to follow. Errors in usage or lacking in use of connectives and sentence endings. Limited vocabulary.
