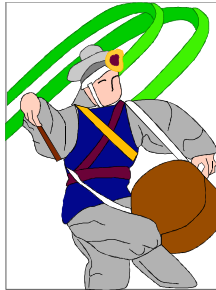

Alpha Mu Gamma is the First and largest national collegiate foreign language honor society of the US. It was established on April 29, 1931 at LACC by 5 members of the foreign language faculty. These 5 members recognized the need for a society to honor achievement in all foreign languages at an early stage in the student's career. The interest shown by the other colleges and universities inspired an almost immediate expansion into a national organization. More than 307 chapters exist in the US, Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands. Chapters are found both in state and private universities, four years as well as two years colleges. The Society has grown so large because it honors excellence in ALL languages so that it encompasses all foreign groups.
