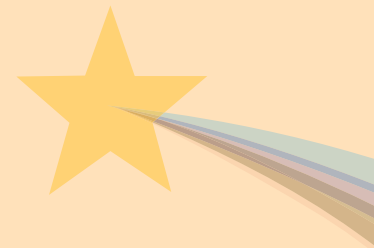




INFANT AND TODDLER STUDIES
