WOMEN'S TRACK & FIELD: THE LATEST ON THE LADY CUBS

The Lady Cubs were short-handed in the California Relays at Cerritos College on Fri., March 21, but made respectable showings in the 100 and 200 meter sprints, and the 5000 meters.

Freshman Veronica Alaniz led the Lady Cubs in the 5000 meters with a 3rd place finish in a time of 19:57.68 minutes.

Freshman Latrice Klyce (Leuzinger) competed in the 100 meters but finished 4th (13.41 seconds) in Preliminaries Heat No. 3 and failed to make the Final Heat. Klyce also ran 4th in the 200 meters (29.68 seconds) Preliminaries Heat No. 2.

BADMINTON: THE LATEST ON THE LADY CUBS

The Lady Cubs suffered losses last week at home against Pasadena City College (March 19) and Compton College (March 21).

The most competitive match of the Pasadena contest was in doubles when the Lady Cubs No. 1 doubles team of freshmen Madison Tarr and Magdalena Rogosz took two games to their 21-point limit before the Lady Lancers prevailed.

Defending South Coast Conference champion Compton College had no problems in winning their singles matches but were nearly upset by LA City's No. 2 doubles team of Yazmeen Townsend and Xiang (Ester) Li. Townsend and Li led in the first game, 16-11, before the Lady Tartars battled back to win, 18-21. LA City played equally as well in the second game and led early but fell in the end, 17-21.

BASEBALL: CUBS CAPTURE DOUBLE HEADER AT BARSTOW BUT DROP THREE GAMES IN VENTURA TOURNAMENT

The Cubs went 2-3 last week in non-conference action. LA City dropped a close game at Ventura College, 9-8 (March 18), in the opening game of the Channel Islands Spring Break Tournament hosted by Ventura College.

After a day off between games, the Cubs returned to Ventura for equally disappointing losses to Porterville College, 9-5, and Oxnard College, 3-1 (March 20).

However, runs favored LA City last Saturday (March 22) when the Cubs won both games of a double-header at Barstow College. LACC blew Barstow off the desert landscape, 12-0, in the first game, and then captured the nightcap, 13-4.

LA City's record improved to 6-19 overall and remained 1-8 in the South Coast Conference.
