

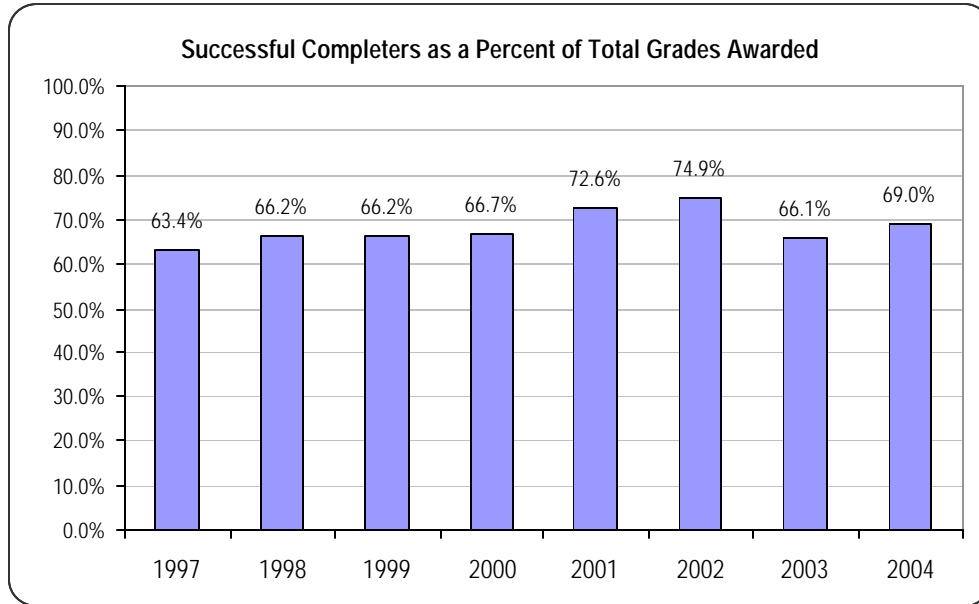

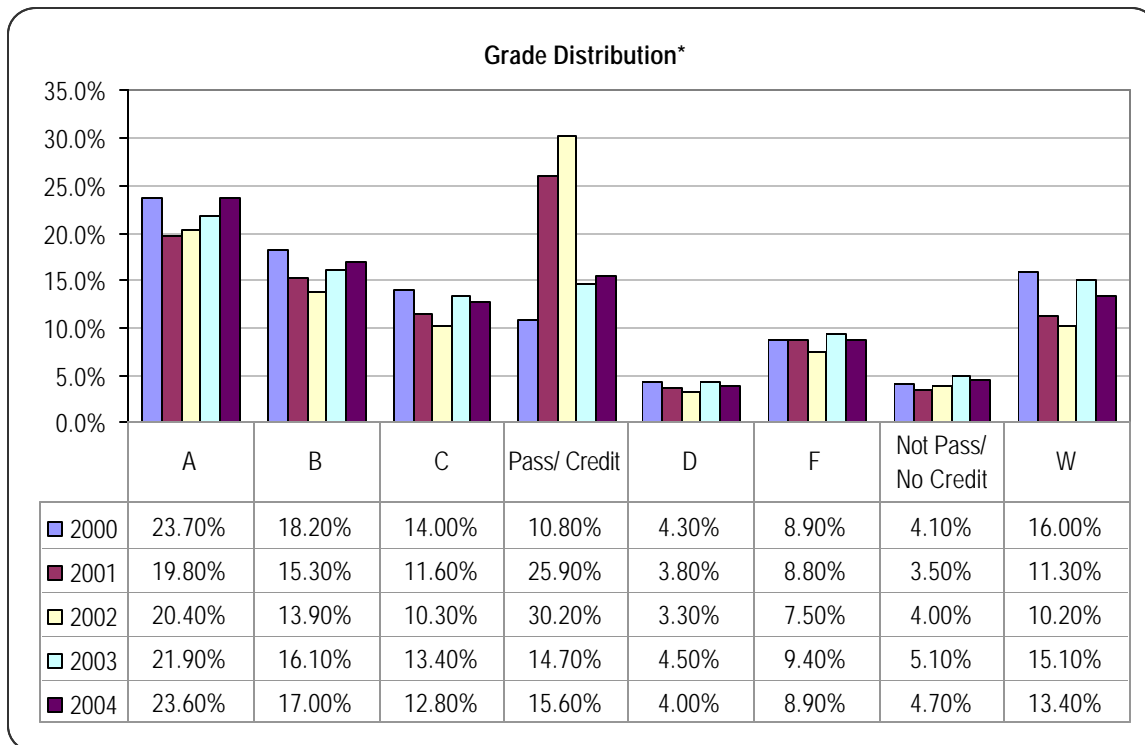

**Note:** Successful completion rate is the percentage of students who receive A, B, C, or pass (P) as compared with those who also receive W, D, F, or not pass (N).

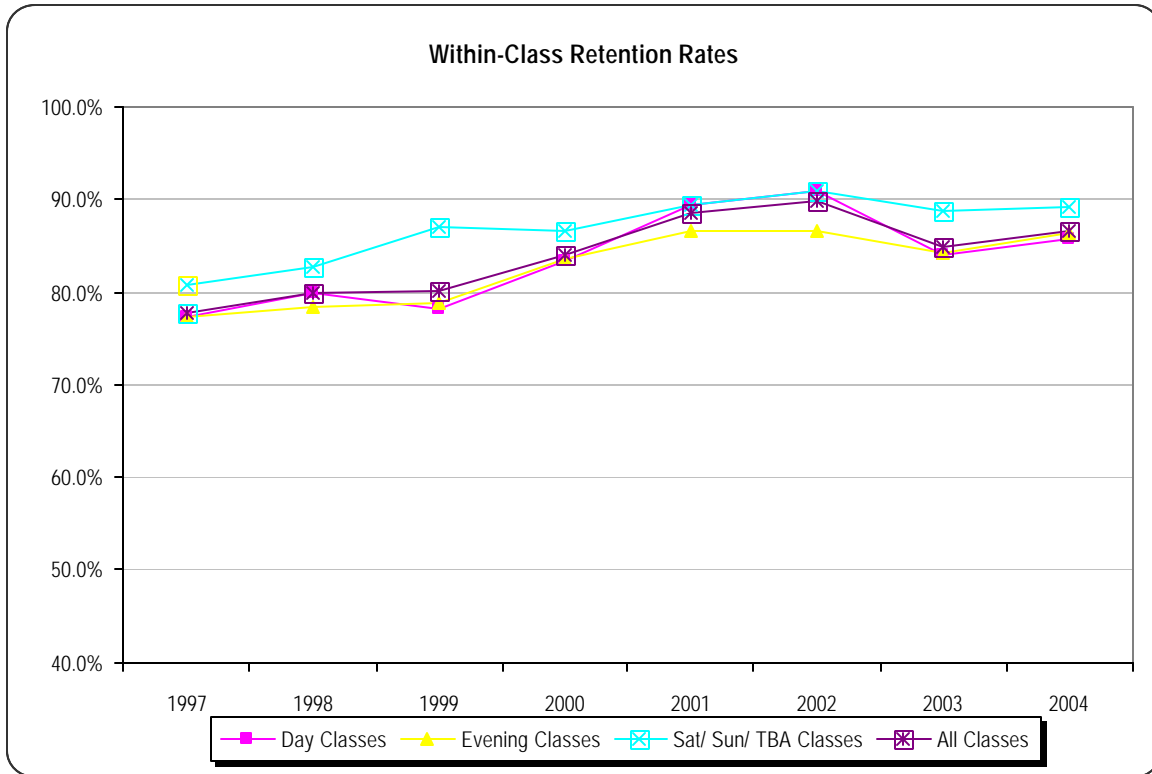

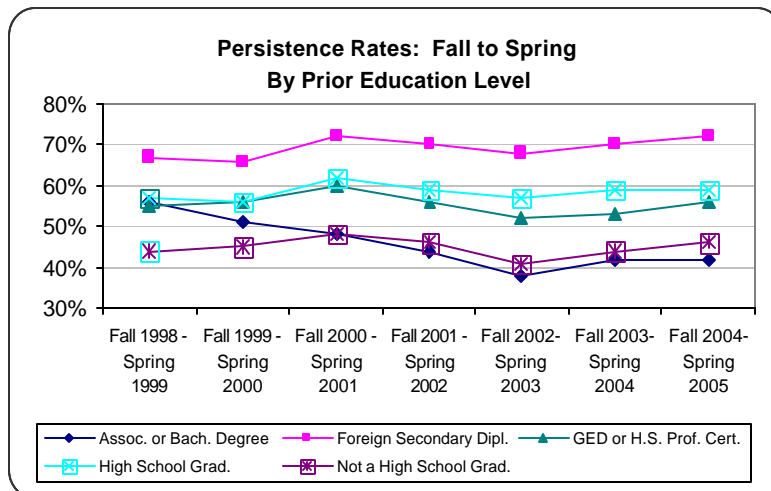

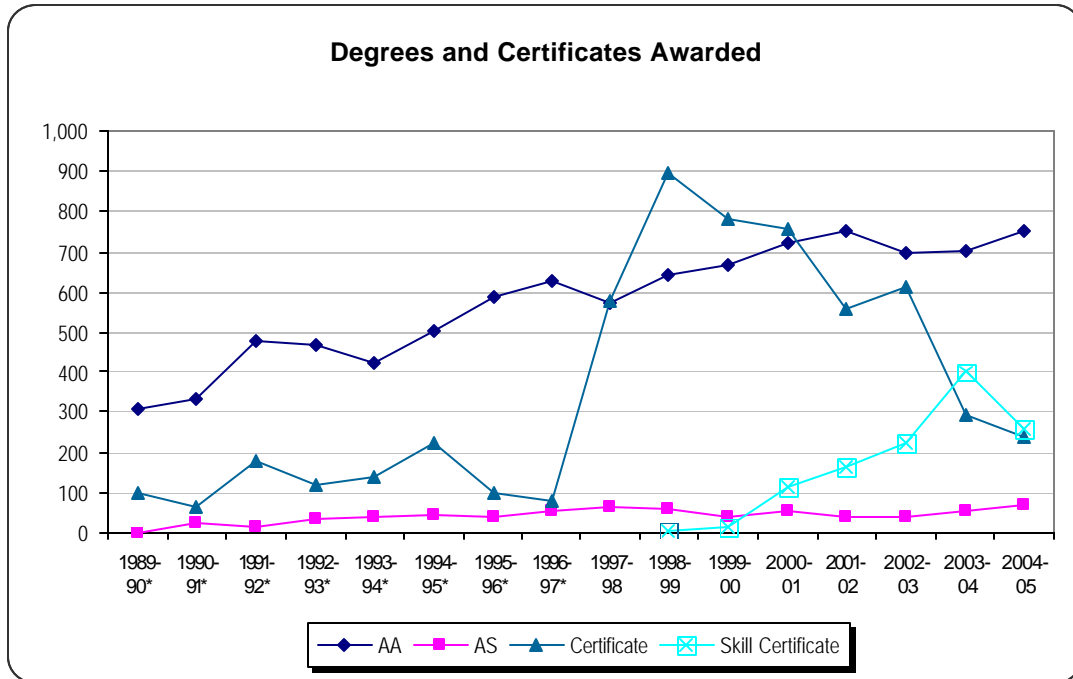

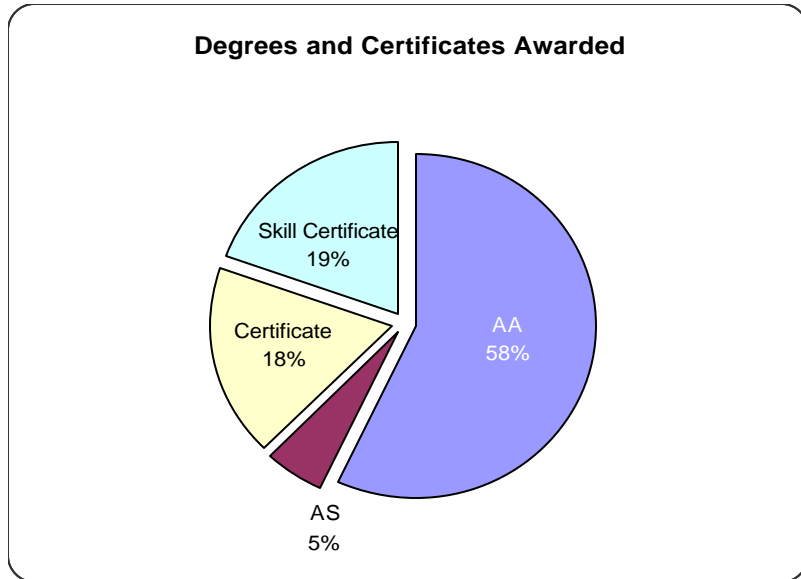

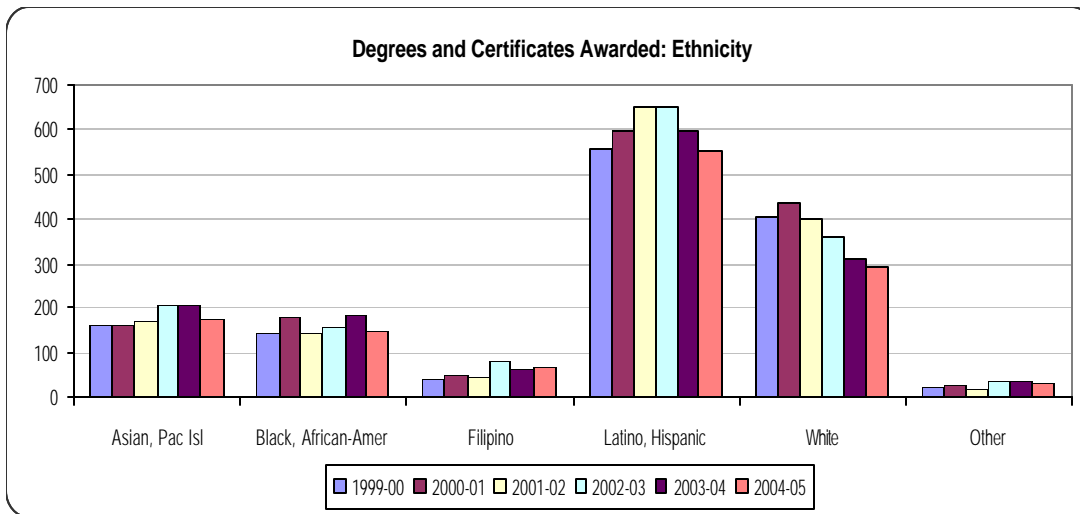
**Associate Degrees and Certificates Awarded - Gender

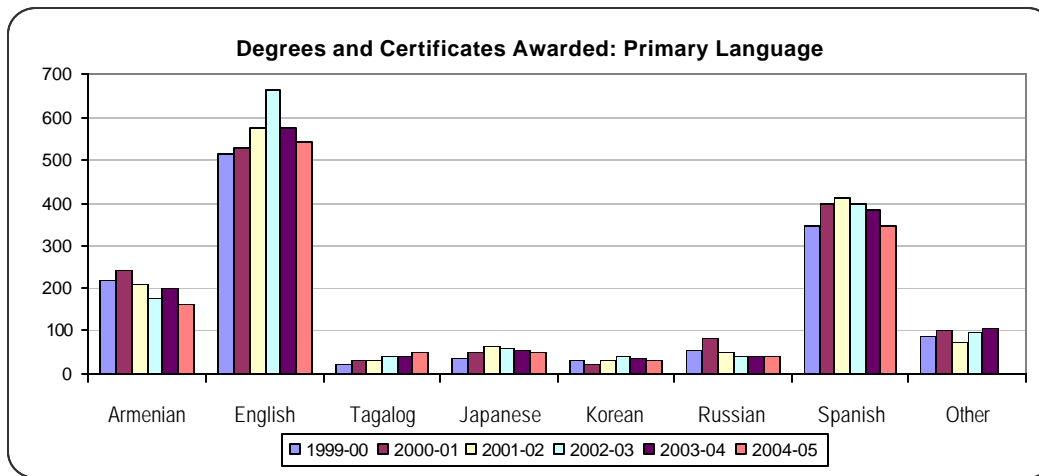
**Associate Degrees and Certificates Awarded - Ethnicity

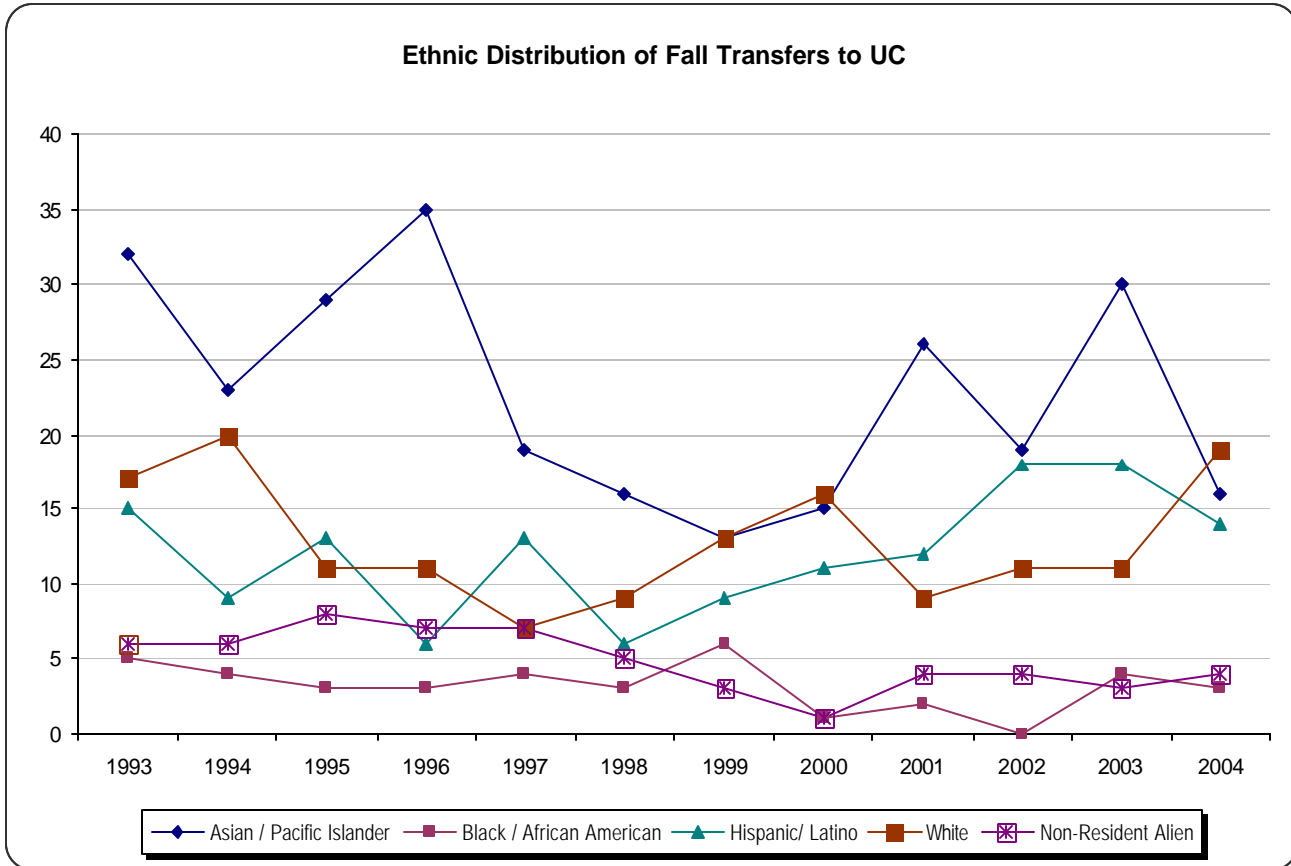

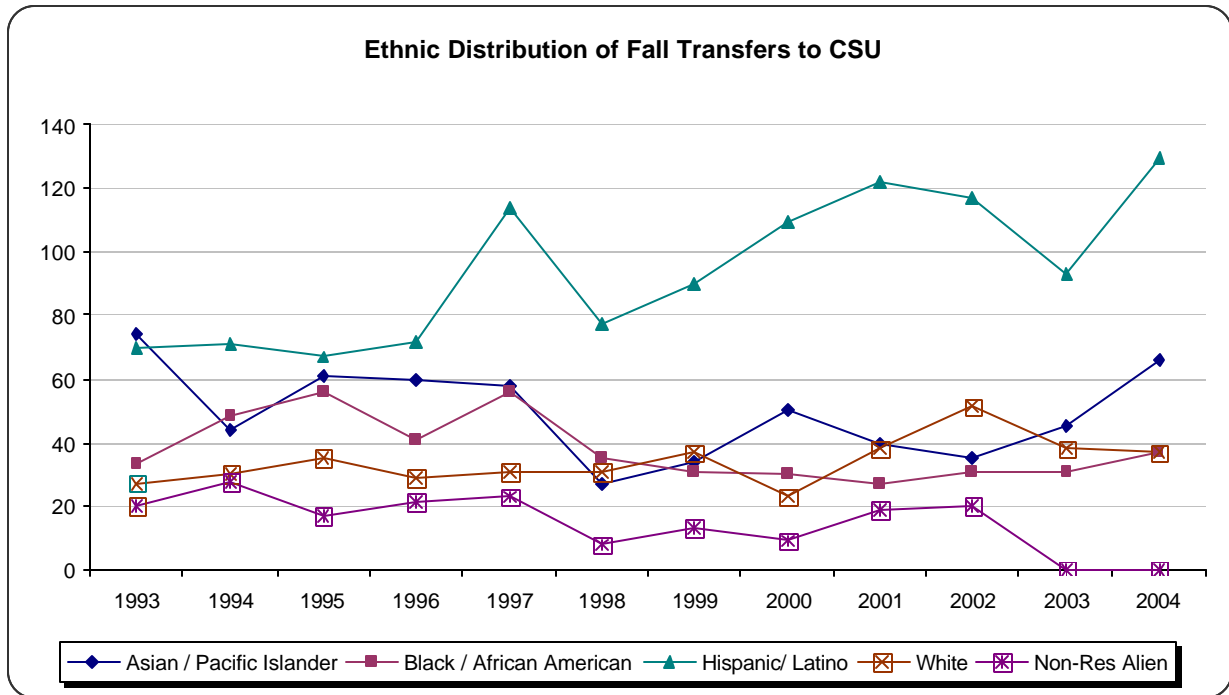

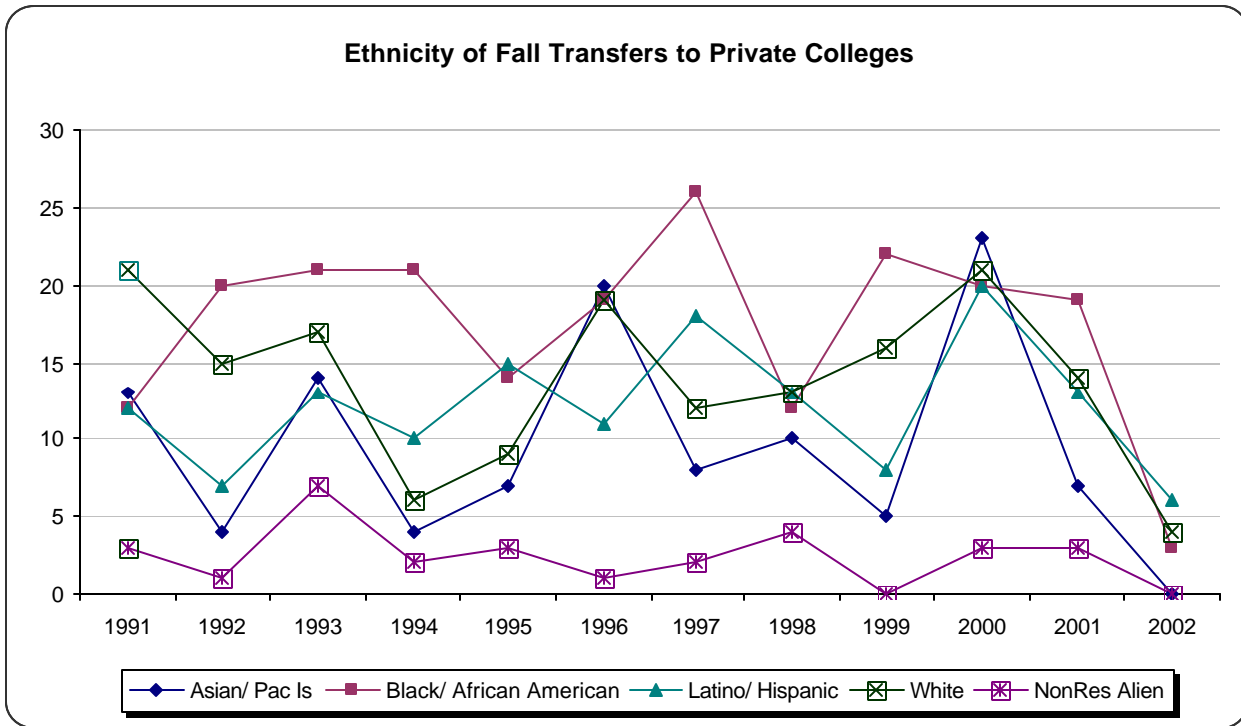
