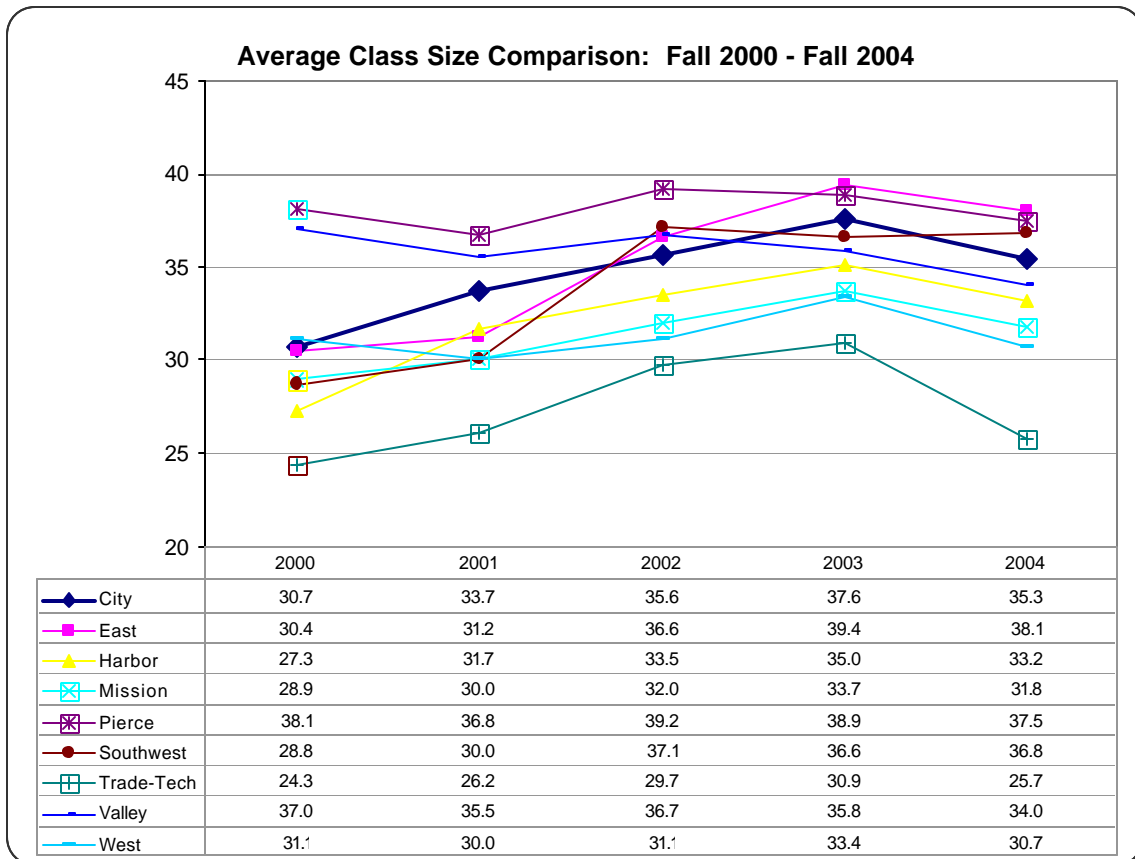

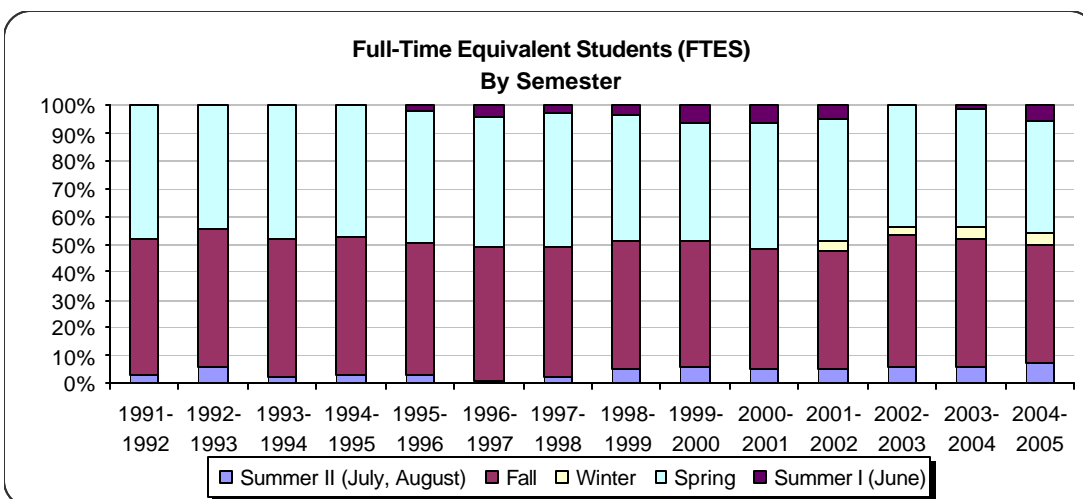
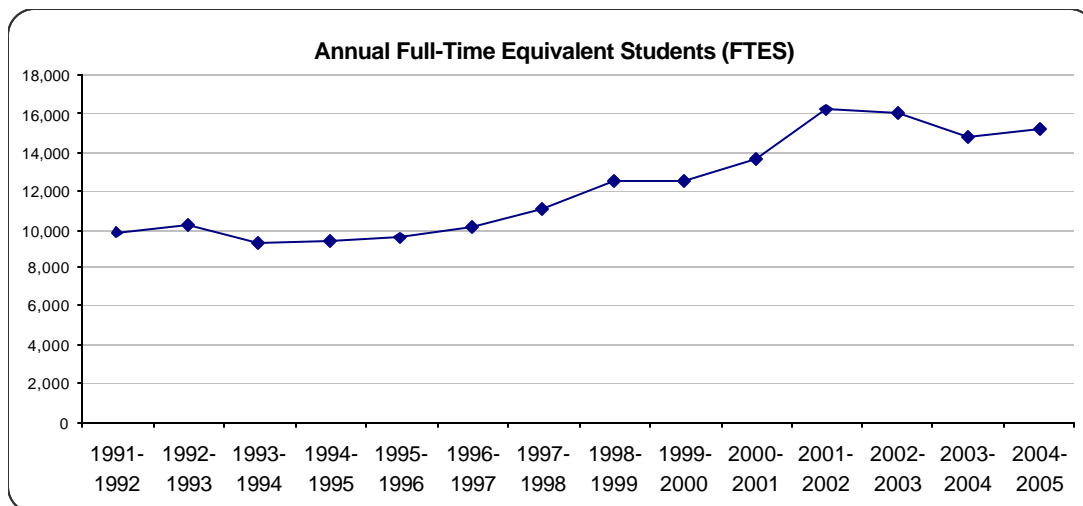
### Average Class Size Comparison Fall 2002 - Fall 2003 - Fall 2004
