The majority of the internships are paid. We encourage all employers to pay, at minimum, City of LA living wage standards.

#### How long do internships typically last?

You can expect to intern 3 to 6 months or more, depending upon the needs of the employer. Keep in mind there is always the possibility for permanent placement.

#### What type of hours will I work?

Work hours are generally flexible and employers will work with your school schedule.

#### How can I prepare?

Visit your campus career center for resume writing, interviewing and career advice. Your campus Co-operative Education program can also provide up to 4 units of credit for eligible work activities.

- Be enrolled in at least six (6) LACCD units, for any current semester, or most recent semester
- Submit an application and a resume online at: [www.laccdinterns.org](http://www.laccdinterns.org)
- Obtain a referral from faculty or the college career center

**To qualify for a full-time (32 – 40 hours) intern position, former students must:**

- Have completed an LACCD certificate program or degree within the past 12 months – **or** – have completed 12 units or more at any LACCD campus within the past six months
- Not be currently enrolled in any LACCD class
