## Expanded Academic ASAP (Gale Group)



From arts and the humanities to science and technology, this database meets research needs across all academic disciplines. Access scholarly journals, magazines and newspapers in one easy-to-use interface.

## Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center (Gale Group)



Contains articles examining different aspects of important social issues with topic overviews, government and organizational statistics, court cases, and profiles of government agencies and special interest groups.

## Biography Resource Center (Gale Group)



This database combines biographies and full-text periodical articles. Facilitates custom search based on one or more personal facts such as birth and death year, nationality, ethnicity, occupation or gender.

## Literature Resource Center (Gale Group)



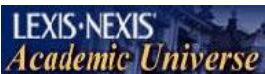
Access biographies, bibliographies, and critical analyses of more than 120,000 authors from every age and literary discipline. It also contains the full text of 600 frequently used Twayne Literary Masters books on notable US and World authors.

## CQ Researcher



Weekly publication providing original in-depth analysis of the most current major and controversial issues of the day with complete summaries, pros and cons, and more.

## LexisNexis Academic



Provides access to a comprehensive spectrum of full-text information from over 5,600 sources selected to meet academic needs and grouped into five categories:

- I. **News** (national and international newspapers, magazines, journals, and broadcast transcripts)
- II. **Business** (business and financial news, company information, market research and more)
- III. **Legal** (U.S. Supreme Court cases, State High Court cases, Law review articles, patents and more)
- III. **Medical** (popular medical news as well as complex issues from medical journals)
- IV. **Reference** (World Almanac, Book of Facts, polls and surveys, state profiles and more).
