**ENL**=English placement test for English speakers. You will complete a computerized exam as well as a written essay. Students can take the English and Math tests with this test. *Allow three hours for the test.*

**ESL**=English placement test for non-native speakers of English. You will complete an essay and multiple choice scantron based test (CELSA) for ESL placement. *Allow 2-2 1/2 hours for the ESL test.*

**Math**=Math placement test. *Allow 2 hour for the test.*

**ATB**=Ability to Benefit test for non-high school graduates seeking federal financial aid. *Allow 2 hours for the test.*

**Chemistry Readiness Exam**= Students desiring to have Chemistry prerequisite (Chem 60/68) waived for Chem 101. Students may take exam only once. *Allow 60 minutes for test.*
