

ELIGIBILITY FOR LEARNING DISABILITIES SERVICES

A student must meet the California Community College Learning Disabilities eligibility criteria by demonstrating average to above average intellectual potential to achieve at the community college. A processing deficit, as measured by various diagnostic procedures, must be present. There must also be a severe discrepancy between the student's intellectual aptitude and academic performance in one or more of the following areas:

- ◆ Basic writing skills
- ◆ Written expression
- ◆ Basic reading skills
- ◆ Reading comprehension
- ◆ Mathematical calculation
- ◆ Mathematical reasoning
