

ELIGIBILITY FOR LEARNING DISABILITIES SERVICES

Community college students must meet the California Community College Learning Disabilities eligibility criteria by demonstrating average to above average intellectual potential. A processing deficit, as measured by various diagnostic procedures, must be present. For a student to be eligible there must also be a severe discrepancy between the student's intellectual aptitude and academic performance in one or more of the following areas:

- ◆ Writing skills
- ◆ Written expression
- ◆ Reading skills
- ◆ Reading comprehension
- ◆ Mathematical calculation
- ◆ Mathematical reasoning
