

Campus Safety & Statistics

The Los Angeles County Sheriff handles police services on the campuses of the Los Angeles Community College District to provide students, faculty and staff with safety on and around the campuses. Contact the College Sheriff to report crimes, injuries and unsafe conditions.

Any emergency situations can be reported by dialing "#3" from any campus phone in and around LACC!

The College Sherriff controls parking, and regulations are strictly enforced. The lost and found is located in the College Sheriff's office. Property turned in will be held for up to ninety (90) days prior to the disposition. Lost keys are held at the dispatch desk. The College Sheriff provides Telecommunication Devices for the Deaf to assist our hearing impaired students
