Program Requirements

Orientation

Attend mandatory GSP Orientation.

Academic Counseling

Complete a minimum of three (3) contacts each semester. Complete an Educational Plan with a GSP or LACC Counselor.

A 2.0 GPA

Maintain a 2.0 GPA. Enroll in a minimum of 9 units.

Tutoring

Attend a minimum of four (4) tutoring sessions each semester.

Workshops & Events

Attend a minimum of four (4) workshops/events each semester.

Counseling 40

Enroll into the Guardian Scholars' Counseling 40 section.

Program Perks

- Computer loan program
- Book loan program
- Access to office's computer lab & printing
- Free testing materials (scantrons & bluebooks)
- Workshops, educational & social activities
- Receive a stipend for attending extra workshops
- Daily snacks & meals

Who Is Eligible?

Any current or former foster youth between the ages of 16 and 24 years is eligible for the program.
