The Office of Outreach and Recruitment at Los Angeles City College (LACC) serves as a liaison to the local community, helps new students with the onboarding process, and educates students about special programs and services at LACC. A significant part of the outreach program caters to the needs of high school students, teachers, counselors, parents. Representatives guide the intake of first time returning students to learn more about LACC, helping them with their first steps to becoming a college student.

Outreach and Recruitment strives to establish educational partnerships with the K-12 school districts facilitating the transition of students from area high schools to LACC or other colleges and universities through regular academic advisement and other pre-graduation activities.
