Workshop Title	Date/Time	Trainer	Class Description
<b>Families and Addiction</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 8, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	This class will explore the impact of substance abuse and addictions in the family system. How does it affect children?
<b>Rights of Resources Parents, Birth Parents, and Out of Home Care Youth</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 10, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	Class will address what are the rights for resource parents, birth parents and foster children. Participants will be able to identify their rights and responsibilities at the end of the class; as well as understand what the rights are for foster children and their biological parents.
<b>Risk Factors</b> (renewal for RFA, W)	August 11, 2023, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Rob Hanna	Class will identify 9 risk factors that put our youth in unhealthy situations, and how we can help teens to stay alive and free from incarceration.
<b>Prudent Parenting</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 15, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	Reasonable Prudent Parenting Standards (RPPS), SB-358 "supports the empowerment of a caregiver to exercise common sense and good judgment to access circumstances and events in which a foster child may participate." This training will cover the specifics of the RPPS and how you should apply it to your foster parenting.
<b>Dealing with Aggressive Youth</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 18, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	Anger is a way to communicate how we feel inside. Many youth that have experienced trauma and abuse behave in an aggressive way. Class will discuss how to deal with aggressive youth, and strategies on how to help them regulate these behaviors.
<b>Recognizing &amp; Preventing Child Neglect</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 21, 2023, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Sandra Smith	The number of children in out-of-home care taking psychotropic medications, and receiving services as D-Rate children has been significantly increasing in the last couple of years. This workshop will present the most common mental illnesses that child and youth get diagnosed with. How to advocate for resources and services, and how to work with youth with mental health issues at home.
<b>Special Care Increment (SCI) Training</b> (Formerly known as D and F-Rate training)	August 22, 23, 24 2023, 5pm-9pm <b>**YOU MUST ATTEND ALL THREE SESSIONS**</b>	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI) Training is the 12 hours foundational training (which replaces the D & F rate pre-service training) for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
<b>Navigating the Court System</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 26, 2023, 10:00am-1:00pm	Denetra Norwood	Navigating the system can be confusing. This workshop will provide you with knowledge and tools on how to navigate the system including DCFS, and the court.

<b>CSEC: Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children</b> (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 28, 2023, 5:00pm-9:00pm	Sandra Smith	Children in out-of-home care are at a higher risk for being sexually exploited. Class will address what CSEC is; how a child becomes a victim; and what are some indicators of exploitation and trafficking. Participants will learn how to help keep their children from becoming victims of sexual exploitation. Instructor will use videos, handouts, and other materials on how to know if our kids are being sexually exploited.
<b>Sense of Belonging: Gangs 101</b> (renewal for RFA, W)	August 31, 2023, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	One basic human need is the sense of belonging and love. Many youth join gangs as they feel they belong to a group. This class will talk about what gangs are about, why children in out-of-home care at risk of joining one, and what you can do as a resource parent to prevent this.
